- 9 Unoaked Chardonnay, Willowood NV California - *A superb wine from the renowned Central Valley in California. The wine is made using state of the art techniques to produce a crisp, dry white wine With refreshing citrus fruit characters and a typical light buttery finish.* £13.25
- 10 Pinot Grigio Ca'Lunghett, IGT, delle Veneto, Botter 2008 Italy - *This light and refreshing wine is produced from vineyards in the beautiful Veneto region. The elegant bouquet displays hints of ripe fruit and flowers. The palate is dry, soft and well-balanced with a full-bodied structure of ripe, refreshing fruit.* £13.40
- 11 Marsanne, Vignoble du sud, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Fonalieu 2005 France - *a young, lively white wine, pale yellow in colour with glints of gold. An exotic and lively nose, characterised by a palate of almonds and white fruit flavour* £13.40
- 15 Sauvignon/Colombard, Katherine Hills 2004/06 - *A unique combination especially selected to Highlight the pungent, tropical freshness typical of both varieties. Sweet, lifted grassiness with passionfruit hints, lead to a crisp easy drinking palate of good length and persistence.* £17.00
- 16 Sauvignon Blanc, Torreón de Paredes 2009 Chile - *Fresh, zingy sauvignon full of tropical fruits On the nose, which delicates notes of lemon peel, crisp and round on the plate. Ideal as an aperitif or with Light dishes.* £17.60
- 17 Viognier Reserve, Catamayor 2007 Uruguay - *The delicate aromas of lychees and peach introduce the wild honey and stone fruit flavours. The lingering creamy finish makes this elegant wine and ideal accompaniment to cream sauce dishes but is equally good on its own as an aperitif.* £20.40

## Rose Wine

- 19 Ca'Lunghetta Pinot Grigio Bluch, IGT, Veneto. Botter 2006 Italy - *The grape is left on the skins for about twelve hours to give the wine its characteristic and pale rose colour. The result is an attractive wine, dry, soft and well-balanced.* £15.10

## Red Wines

### Bin No.

- 20 Pinotage, 2008 South Africa - *From a grape variety unique to the Cape, this is a delicious red wine with attractive berry fruit and plenty of grip. Once you have tasted this grape variety, it will become a firm favourite.* £13.75
- 21 Cabernet Sauvignon, 2007, Chile - *Deep brilliant red ruby colour with blue and black notes. Black fruits, cassis, herbal and floral aromas with touches of regalis, plum and chocolate. In the mouth it is soft, long and persistent with mature, firm and well rounded tannins.* £13.30
- 22 Shiraz/Cabernet, Katherine Hills 2005 Australia- *A spicy, berry flavours complexed by a touch of mint, dominate this wine. The warm, ripe, savoury fruit results in a soft, rounded palate showing great length* £13.40

23	Merlot, Torreon, de Paredes 2008 Chile - <i>This rich, ruby-red Merlot from Chile has the sweet vanilla aromas from ageing in oak barrels. It shows a good balance of fruit and tannin with a lovely, long finish.</i>	£14.60
24	Chianti, Ruffino 2005 Italy - <i>Ruby red with light violet and red berry characters. On the palate the wine shows good "typicity" of Chianti. Delicious, tasty, lots of fruit and fragrance. A classic Italian red with fragrant cherry notes and a medium bodied, delicious earthy taste.</i>	£15.40

27	Zinfandel, Blackstone Winery 2006 California - <i>Rich in purple plum, smokey oak and vanilla aromas/ the wine has intense flavours of fresh and stewed plums, with distinctive spice and black pepper overtones.</i>	£18.50
29	Cotes du rhone rouge, Les Radassieres, Maison bouchon 2007 France - <i>Aromas of fresh fruits and mild spices make this wine very approachable and easy to drink.</i>	£20.40
30	Beaujolais Villages, louis latour 2008 France - <i>From the Beaujolais village of Lancie the red possesses and intense, scented bouquet coupled with rich flavour and persistent fruit aftertaste.</i>	£21.00
